



Call for Nominations 2010 Division of Medicinal Chemistry Award

Nominations are now being accepted for the 2009 Division of Medicinal Chemistry Award. This award is open to any scientist or team of scientists from the U.S. or abroad whose research has had, directly or indirectly, a significant effect on medicinal chemistry. Although other types of accomplishments (such as a new research tool) will not be excluded, emphasis will be placed on contributions to the discipline of medicinal chemistry, broadly defined, and scientists whose accomplishments have not already been previously recognized in the form of other honors. The award will be presented as a part of a special session at the 2010 National Medicinal Chemistry Symposium held at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, MN, June 6-9, 2010.

Nominations must include a detailed letter describing the candidate's research accomplishments and contributions to medicinal chemistry, at least one seconding letter, and a current curriculum vitae of the nominee(s).
